This trip has to be well prepared, because as harmless and romantic the individual islands are, the more treacherous the crossing can be. You should avoid wind against tide situations and should have your own dinghy to get to some islands. The coast from Cherbourg to St. Malo offers not only historical things like Le Mont-Saint-Michel but also fantastic beaches and sometimes a tidal range of 14m. In addition, this stretch of coast trumps with some beautiful towns that stand for the special atmosphere of Brittany. We can particularly recommend Saint-Malo - a city with a historic center that is completely surrounded by a city wall.
